- Applicants must be registered as a FULL-TIME student on a course in a registered Institute of Technology, University, Post Leaving Certificate Course or equivalent distance learning course.
- The applicant should normally not be less than 17 years of age.
- Eligible expenses include fees, books, materials, rent, transport & childcare.
- Scholarships are **NOT** available for those pursuing a **HDip**.
