For example, Local Links Kerry – established by our local development companies 20 years ago - now operates bus services throughout Kerry to better connect all our communities.

We have four Local Area Advisory Councils (LAACs) who meet regularly to discuss issues, undertake intiatives, and recommend actions to NewKD. Each LAAC is composed of volunteer representatives of local organisations and interests. The LAACs are Greater Tralee, North Kerry, Sliabh Luachra and Chorca Dhuibhne, with each area having a local office (per map on back cover).

With all our work NEWKD's aim is to improve people's quality of life by helping to build a more just, inclusive, equitable, sustainable and fair society. C. Enterprise & Tourism Supports / Tacaíochtaí Fiontraíochta & Turasóireachta

SafeTractor Driving Skills

Rural Social Scheme / An Scéim Shóisialta Tuaithe

This programme provides additional income for farmers and fishers who receive long-term social welfare payments. In return, participants provide certain services that will benefit the rural community like:

D. Social Supports / Tacaíochtaí Sóisialta

North Kerry Home Maintenance Service / Cothabháil Tí do Sheanóirí (Clár Seirbhísí Pobail)

NEWKD provide a low-cost maintenance and minor repair service in the North Kerry area. The service is provided to those who are in most need in the community like older people living alone or with an older spouse / partner, people living in poor housing conditions, people with disabilities or in poor health, and people living in isolated areas. Senior Alert Scheme / Scéim Foláirimh do Sheanóirí

This scheme enables older persons to continue to live securely in their homes by providing them with a personal monitored alarm. People over 65 get a free personal alarm or pendant. The alarm can be worn as a pendant or around the wrist like a watch. For more information, contact **Dympna on 068 23429.**

Home Visitation Service / Clár Cuairte Tí

This is a free social visiting service for people over 60 years in the North Kerry area in particular Moyvane, Listowel, Ballydonoghue, Duagh, Causeway, Ballyduff, Tarbet, Ballybunion, Asdee and Ballylondford. Our Rural Social Scheme (RSS) offers once-a-week social visit, to support an older person and to link them to other existing community services in the area. We organize a pair of dedicated RSS and voluntary people who are there to listen and engage on regular basis.
