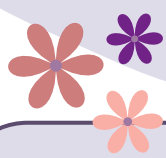

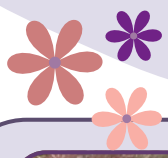


Knitted baby gowns for newborns in Africa

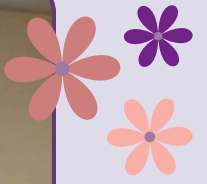

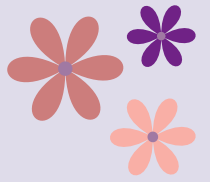
